### Day 1 : Depart Singapore - Incheon

Assemble at Changi International Airport for your flight to the 'Land of Modern Miracles and Ancient Traditions', South Korea.

### Day 2 : Incheon - Gimpo → Jeju Island (L/D)

Upon arrival Incheon, transfer to Gimpo Airport for your domestic flight to Jeju Island. Head off to **Yongduam Rock** for the rock formation, similar of a dragon head! Next, more photo opportunity at **Sumokwon Theme Park 3D Art Museum and Ice Gallery**.  
**Overnight – Jeju S Hotel or similar**

### Day 3 : Gangwon-do (B/L/D)

Today, begin your tour at **Seongsan Ilchulbong Sunrise Peak**, one of the seven wonders of nature in the world! We will make a stop at **Seongeup Folk Village** where the houses were built from volcanic rocks and thatched roofs. Continue to scenic coastal view at **Seopjikoji**. Next, have fun at the **Teddy Bear museum** that exhibits all sorts of teddy bears. Lastly, visit **Cheonjiyeon Waterfalls** before heading back to Hotel.  
**Overnight – Jeju S Hotel or similar**

### Day 4 : Jeju Island → Gimpo – Gyeonggi-do - Gangwon-do (B/L)

After breakfast, transfer to airport for your domestic flight back to Gimpo and journey to **Nami Island**. During spring, this island is surrounded by cherry blossom. Thereafter, experience Rail Biking.  
**Overnight – Daemyung Resort or similar**

### Day 5 : Gangwon-do – Gyeonggi-do (B/D)

This morning proceed to **Mount Seorak National Park and Sinheungsa Temple**. Start your fun at Korea largest outdoor theme park **Everland**. During Spring, the whole park will be decorated with cherry blossoms, tulips and many florals. Not to miss out Safari World where you can get close to animals and T Express ride for the brave at heart .

**Overnight – Suwon Korea Hotel or similar**

### Day 6 : Gyeonggi-do - Seoul (B/L)

Start the day with a visit to **Suwon Hwaseong Fortress** – a UNESCO World Heritage site. Continue to **Provence French Village**, a beautiful fairy tale-like village where small pastel tones building cluster together. Then make a stop at **Paju Premium Outlet** for shopping. Arriving Seoul, visit **Seaweed Museum** followed by wearing of **Traditional Hanbok costumes**. Lastly, start your shopping spree at **Dongdaemun**.

**Overnight – Ibis Insadong Hotel or similar**

### Day 7 : Seoul (B/L)

This morning, visit **Deoksu Palace**, one of the five grand palace in seoul. Next head off to **Namsan Park** for more Cherry blossom . Thereafter continue your shopping spree at **Ginseng Gallery, Cosmetic Duty Free Shop and Myeongdong**. Lastly, enjoy nonverbal performance **Bibap Show**, basing on the dish bibimbap. The actors mimic the sound of making bibimbap with beat-boxing and a cappella, demonstration through b-boying, acrobatics and martial arts.

### Day 8 : Singapore (B)

Today, have your last minute shopping at **Sinchon Street and Ikganbo**. Stopover at **Local Product Shop** before transferring to Incheon Airport for your flight back to Singapore.
